- 1925 – Aimé Tschiffely of Switzerland – Argentina to Washington DC.
- 1930 – Countess Linde von Rosen of Sweden – Stockholm to Rome.
- 1939 – Mary Bosanquet of England – Vancouver to New York.
- 1941 – Wilfred Skrede of Norway – Kashgar to Srinagar.
- 1942 – Count Ilia Tolstoy of Russia – India to China via Tibet.
- 1950 – Ana Beker of Argentina – Buenos Aires to Ottawa.
- 1965 – William Holt of England – (age 65) 6,000 miles through Europe.
- 1977 – Otto Schwarz of Switzerland – 48,000 kilometres on four continents.
